City of Lapeer's DPW is hiring a **Full-Time Utilities Troubleshooter II/Equipment Operator IV** position, water division (DEQ water license is a plus). This is an AFSCME Union position, with a starting wage of \$20.35/hour with an Excellent Benefit Package, including MERS Defined Benefit Retirement Program, 40 hour week/some overtime as needed. This position may develop into a leadership role. Employees within this class are distinguished from the Utilities Troubleshooter I/Equipment Operator III by their performance in having additional equipment and utility construction skill sets, plus knowledge which results in expanded duties and responsibilities. . An employee in this class performs semi-skilled and skilled labor in construction, maintenance and repair and service activities as it relates to utility infrastructure. Within the Department of Public Works all divisions: Streets, Utilities, and the Wastewater Treatment Plant are cross trained. Job assignments may include work in all three divisions. In performing these duties you will need to operate various types of equipment that range from light duty to heavy duty along with specialized equipment.
